Patty Dean called the meeting to order. Congratulations and Thank Yous to Program Chairs and all Board Members contributing to success of 2013 Program.

The Directory & Leadership Responsibilities Documents were quickly reviewed.

Reports:

- <u>2014 Program.</u> Andrea Karlin & Kenny Fasching-Varner, are continuing as Program Co-Chairs for 2014. Kenny will submit data to IRA this year.
- <u>Presenters' handouts on Web-site</u>. Program Chair needs to remind presenters they can post handouts and presentation summaries on the LSR Web-site.
- <u>Awards Program—Flyer, Guidelines, Publicity.</u> Denise Stuart reported that we need more submissions for the Literacy and Service award for students. There is a need for improved publicity and getting the word out. A one-page flyer was posted at the end of the 2012 issue of the e-journal and should continue.
- <u>Instructional Strategies Strand for Web-site, Membership, & Treasury.</u> Beth Breneman reported that she has submitted write-ups of five Best Literacy Practices + Pro-social Twists for the L-SR Web-site: KWL, Literature Circles, RAFT, Reading from Different

Perspectives, and Inquiry. Beth suggested that the L-SR SIG begin recruiting Past IRA Presidents as SIG members. We currently have \$2250.60 in the SIG Treasury.

• <u>Transition to New Communications Chair</u>. Rebekah Kelleher is the new Communications Chair. Rebekah will begin work on updating the e-List, which needs updating due to lots of new members.

Planning Ahead

- The 2014 IRA Annual Convention is set to take place in New Orleans. The time slot for the L-SR SIG is unclear. Keynote speakers were suggested.
- Margaret-Mary Sulentic Dowell nominated Tynisha Meidl, Assistant Professor at St. Norbert's, De Pere, WI, as co-editor of the Literacy and Social Responsibility eJournal. A vote was called, and Tynisha was unanimously voted into this position.
- Denise Stuart requested a new awards chair person beginning the 2013-14 year
- Susanne Gervay from Sydney Australia has contributed a body of work on social justice issues. The book committee can read her work over the 2013-14 year and plan to honor her at our SIG in 2015.
- The idea of conducting a raffle with the books that are read by the book committee was suggested and discussed.
- A new by-law on the treasury is needed. A co-signee on the L-SR bank account needs to be established with current and future L-SR Treasurers to optimize flexibility for accessing resources--a common practice in many organizations.
